ABOUT TAC

The **TAC** program is a nationally recognized, evidence-based, postgraduate training program for licensed clinicians who work with adoptive families in a broad range of settings. **TAC** is accredited by the **Institute for Credentialing Excellence** and is the only accredited certificate program in adoption competency in the country

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Must be Master's level therapists who are licensed (or working towards licensure) in Utah
- Prefer therapists who are currently serving children in and/or adopted from foster care
- Training is limited to 24 people
- Applicants accepted into the class must sign a participant agreement and agree to attend all sessions (please note that make-up work is allowed for two modules)
- Interested applicants must complete the **TAC application**
